

## PINE GROVE AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT PARKING REGULATIONS

Students are reminded that driving to school is a privilege and not a right; violation of parking regulations and/or the exhibition of poor driving judgment could result in the suspension of this privilege and possible fines.

1. During the school day, no student may drive or park a vehicle on Pine Grove Area School District property without proper authorization from the building administration.
2. Seniors will be granted the privilege of parking on school property during the school day based on random assignment depending on availability.
3. A waiting list will be established (if necessary). If a parking permit is permanently revoked, it will be given to the first person on the waiting list.

### **Procedures to Register a Vehicle**

1. All vehicles must be registered in the high school office to park on school property. Approved students will be issued a parking tag at the cost of \$5.00. Lost tags will be replaced for a fee of \$3.00. If a tag is revoked for any reason, the tag fee will not be refunded.
2. The student registering the vehicle must provide a valid Pennsylvania driver's license and a completed parking application.

### **Parking Regulations**

1. All cars must be registered with the building administration by obtaining a registration tag and completing proper forms. Registration tags must be displayed in the vehicle at all times while on school property.
2. No cars are to be moved during the day without permission from the administration.
3. Students are to use designated parking areas only.
4. Students should lock their vehicles at all times during the school day.
5. No student will be permitted in his/her vehicle during the school day without prior permission from a school administrator.
6. Vehicles not properly registered or parked illegally may be towed from the school parking lot at the owner's expense.
7. School officials reserve the right to inspect vehicles on school property. Students are responsible for the contents of their vehicle.
8. Students are not permitted in the parking lot except during the time of arrival and departure from school without permission from the building administration.
9. Students should not arrive at school prior to the doors opening unless prior permission is granted. Students may not loiter in their vehicles.
10. Parking tags are given to individuals for specific vehicles. Only the person for whom the tag was issued may use the parking tag.
11. Students must obey all Pennsylvania laws while on school property.
12. Driving recklessly, exceeding the speed limit, and/or parking illegally may be reported to the police.
13. Violations of these regulations will result in disciplinary actions which may include detention, suspension or parking privileges being revoked.

### **Other Regulations Pertaining to Attendance, Behavior and Financial Obligations**

1. Students who are tardy to school more than four times will have their parking privileges revoked for the remainder of the school year.
2. Under the provisions of Board Policy 218 Student Discipline, disciplinary consequences may be imposed for the following reasons:
  - a. No parking permit displayed
  - b. Vehicle not registered
  - c. Unauthorized use of another student's permit
  - d. Vehicle parked improperly
  - e. Inappropriate behavior related to vehicle on school property
3. School financial obligations must be cleared to receive or retain a parking permit.
4. Failure to return the parking permit to the high school office at the end of the year will result in an obligation being issued.
