Rent from Loser's Music Store in Lebanon. Fill out the contract. <u>Mail the paper copy with</u> <u>payment to the store or fill out online at https://www.losersmusic.com/</u>. Loser's delivers the instrument and all supplies to the school. When needing repair, they pick up from the school and I have loaner instruments available so your child can continue playing. I can only provide loaners for students who rent from Loser's. If we find the instrument your child has chosen is not a good fit, Loser's will allow your child to switch instruments, often for little or no additional cost. Cost for the 4 month trial period is approximately \$95 including instrument, music and stand. <u>Sept 9th at 6 PM in the LGI a sales</u> representative will be here to answer any questions and you may have.
