ELA Activity # 1: "There Was An Old Lady Who Swallowed A Shell"

Goal:

The students will listen to the story.

The students will understand story order.

The students will demonstrate their understanding of cause and effect.

The students will show their understanding of parts of speech.

The students will show their understanding of ABC order.

Materials:

<u>"There Was An Old Lady Who Swallowed a Shell"</u> Video "There Was An Old Lady Who Swallowed A Shell" Worksheets

Directions:

- 1. Listen to the story. "There Was An Old Lady Who Swallowed a Shell"
- 2. Complete the worksheet Cause and Effect. You can write the answers in the boxes rather than cutting and pasting. If you want to print the worksheet and do the cut and paste, you can send a picture of it to your teacher.
- 3. Complete the worksheet with Parts of speech. Write the answers and return to your teacher or cut and paste and send a picture.
- 4. Complete the worksheet with ABC order. Write the answers and return to your teacher or cut and paste and send a picture.

ELA Activity #2: FUNdations Skills and Phonics Review

Goal:

Students will understand the sounds of the vowel teams.

Students will identify rhyming words.

Students will identify long and short vowel words.

Students will identify words with one, two, and three syllables.

Materials:

Paper/pencil Scissors and Glue (optional) Videos in the directions/video list Worksheets in the directions/resource list

Directions:

- 1. Listen to and repeat the Vowel Team Sounds
- 2. Listen to "<u>Commotion in the Ocean</u>" by <u>Giles Andreae</u>. As you listen to the story, call out the rhyming words that you hear on each page.
- 3. Listen to Long and Short Vowel Sounds. Play along and try to beat the video and say if the word has a long vowel sound or a short vowel sound.
- 4. Use the <u>Sandcastle Long and Short Vowel Worksheet</u> to build your own long and short vowel words. You do not need to cut out the letters. Write your words in the long and short vowel columns.

Download the worksheet, type your answers, save it, and e-mail it to your teacher *OR* take a picture of your work and e-mail it to your teacher.

- 5. Watch the <u>Learn Syllables Video</u>. Make sure you have enough room to clap, stomp, and chomp along with the video!
- 6. Complete the <u>Syllables Beach Wordsort</u>.

- 2. Listen to Count by 5's | Grandma and Grandpa at the Beach | Jack Hartmann.
- 3. Play <u>Roll, Add, Win</u>.
- 4. Complete <u>Beach Review</u>.
- 5. Optional Games:

- <u>Treasure Hunt</u> Reviews two digit addition and 2 digit subtraction.
- Summertime Spot the Shapes
- Math Games You do not have to subscribe. You can play the games listed for free.

Science Activity: Sink or Float?

Goal: Students will explore the concept of sinking and floating.

Materials:

pencil worksheet or blank sheet of paper a container of water 5 random objects to place into water

Directions:

- 1. Watch the <u>Sink or Float video</u>.
- Complete your own "Sink or Float" experiment by choosing 5 random objects and testing their buoyancy in a container of water. Complete the <u>"Sink or Float" worksheet</u> (this worksheet is fillable online) or write your predictions and observations on a piece of paper.

Materials:

Directions:

- 1. Have the student read over the Fry's Sight Word sentences provided. Help him/her with any words he/she is having trouble with. <u>Fry's Sight Word Sentences 81-100</u>
- 2. Have the student practice reading the sentences multiple times with an adult or older sibling until he/she can read them fluently without making any errors.
