Goal: The students will observe a variety of animals within a zoo setting.

Materials:

The View at the Zoo Welcome to the Zoo San Diego Zoo Paper Pencil Markers/Crayons

Directions:

- 1. Listen to the story, <u>The View at the Zoo</u>.
- 2. Listen to the song, <u>Welcome to the Zoo</u>.
- 3. Visit the <u>San Diego Zoo</u>.
- 4. Optional : Draw a picture of your favorite zoo animal. Write about it. Include the following:
 - Tell what your zoo animal is.
 - Describe what your zoo animal looks like.

- Explain what the zoo animal was doing when you watched it
- Write why you picked this zoo animal.

Activity # 1: National Symbols - Mini Virtual Field Trips

Goal: Students will explore and learn facts about United States Symbols.

Materials:

Videos provided in the directions/video links

Optional - A Pencil and the Logging Your Adventure Worksheet provided in the directions/resource section

Directions:

- 1. Take a Tour of <u>The White House</u>
- 2. Watch the Video The Statue Of Liberty for Kids Famous World Landmarks
- 3. Visit the Inside of the Statue of Liberty by <u>Climbing to the Crown of the Statue of Liberty 377</u> <u>Steps</u>
- 4. Visit The Liberty Bell
- 5. Watch the Video The Bald Eagle
- 6. Watch the Video The American Flag
- 7. Visit Mount Rushmore for Kids Famous World Landmarks
- 8. Optional Use the worksheet <u>Logging Your Adventures</u> to write about one or more of the national symbols you visited or learned about

Activity #2: Backyard Scavenger Hunt

Goal: Students will read backyard themed words.

Students will review adjectives.

Students will identify and find items in their backyard using a checklist.

Materials:

Pencil Crayons Backyard Scavenger Hunt

Directions:

- 1. Read the <u>Backyard Scavenger Hunt</u> items to an adult.
- 2. Find each item on your scavenger hunt paper.
- 3. Color the picture of each item as you find it.
- 4. Complete the Bonus Items section by finding and writing the names of items that match the adjective given.

Activity #3: Salt Playdough

Goal: Students will measure and mix ingredients to make playdough.

Materials:

Bowl Mixing spoon 1 cup of salt 1 cup of water 2 cups of flour 1 tablespoon of cooking oil Food coloring (optional)

Directions:

- 1. If you want to use food coloring, make sure to mix it with the water before adding it to the other ingredients.
- 2. Mix all the ingredients together.
- 3. Knead the mixture until it is doughy.
- 4. That's it! Have fun creating with your new playdough!

Activity #4: Oobleck

Goal: Students will create oobleck and use their senses to explore the mixture.

Materials:

Cornstarch Water Bowl measuring cup Green food coloring (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Watch <u>Bartholomew and The Oobleck</u> by Dr. Seuss.
- 2. Make oobleck!

Directions:

- Pour 1 ½ cups of cornstarch into a bowl. Add a few drops of green food coloring to 1 cup of water. Slowly add the water and mix until the oobleck becomes thick.
- Pointers: If the oobleck seems runny, add a bit more cornstarch. If the oobleck is dry, add more water. (Oobleck should flow when the bowl is tipped and feel like a sold when it is not). DO NOT EAT OR TASTE IT.
- Tips for cleanup: Do NOT pour oobleck down the drain it will clog it!

- 3. Use your senses to describe the mixture.
 - Does it have a smell?
 - What does it feel like?
 - What does it look like?
 - Does it make any sounds?

***Do you think oobleck is a solid or a liquid? Why?

Activity #5: Live Cam of Animals in Their Habitats

Goal: Students will observe live animals in habitats.

Materials:

Live Cam

Directions:

- 1. Click on the link and view live animals in their own habitats. Live Cam
- 2. Choose and explore the different animals and habitats listed that interest you.

Activity #6: Slime

Goal: Students will use measuring to create slime and use their senses to explore the mixture.

Materials:

½ Cup Elmer's Washable PVA Clear or White Glue
¼-½ Cup of Liquid Starch
½ Cup of Hot Water
Water Color or Food Coloring (Optional)

Directions:

- 1. In a bowl combine $\frac{1}{2}$ cup hot water and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of glue (mix well to blend completely).
- 2. Optional: Add color to the glue mixture.
- 3. Pour in ¹/₄ cup of liquid starch. Mix the ingredients together.
- 4. Move the slime around in your hands and you will notice the changes.

DO NOT EAT or TASTE THE SLIME

- DO NOT POUR THE SLIME DOWN THE DRAIN
- 5. Use your senses to describe the mixture.
 - Does it have a smell?
 - What does it feel like?
 - What does it look like?
 - Does it make any sounds?
- 6. Have fun with your slime!
