Activity #3: How do animals stay warm

Goal: Students will discover how animals stay warm using their blubber or fat.

Materials:

Latex/plastic Gloves Shortening or Lard

Ice

Water

Bin

stopwatch

Directions:

- BLUBBER EXPERIMENT INSTRUCTIONS
- 2. Place ice and water in a washing up bowl.
- 3. Carefully place your hands in the ice water and time how long you can keep them in the water before it gets uncomfortable be careful not to leave them in longer than that.
- 4. Put the glove on and cover with lard or shortening.
- 5. Put the gloved hand in the ice water and time how long it takes to feel uncomfortable this time.

6. Think about the experiment and which hand you could keep in the ice water longer and why.
