Good afternoon Cardinals:

Please review the following updates.

1. Instruction Continuity Plan - May 20<sup>th</sup> was our final day of instruction for Senior's with June 3<sup>rd</sup> being the last day for all other grade levels. Grading procedures for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter were approved previously as part of our plan and can be referenced on our school website. Please encourage your child to stay engaged through the final day.

2. Online Learning Survey - In the near future we will push out a survey which will focus on Online Learning. With the uncertainty of what the Fall season may bring us, it is imperative we reflect on what worked – what did not work – and how we can improve. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to communicate with your child so their input can be received and help us redefine our instruction.

3. Meals- We will be having our final two meal distributions over the next two weeks. On Wednesday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, we will distribute meals for three days and on Monday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, we will distribute meals for two days. That will be our final meal distribution. Please note that no meals will be served on Memorial Day. We would like to thank Metz Culinary Management, the Pine Grove Area Education Association, and the numerous benefactors who have helped support the student meal program during this school closure. They have been great partners.

4. Graduation – In this time of COVID-19, a world event like no other in our lifetime, I truly hope you are taking time to find joy in even the smallest things as you continue your journey toward one of the most important milestones in your lives. It's at a time like this that all of us must come together to do the best we can, like creating the best and safest possible graduation experience that will honor our Seniors and their achievements while fulfilling our legal obligations with the state. We are excited that the creation of our virtual graduation ceremony is well under way and we thank everyone for your support through that process. Our official virtual ceremony will be released on June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00pm.

I am now able to share official board approved plans for our Class of 2020 graduation/celebrations.

- Our School Board has approved maintaining June 3, 2020 as the "official" Pine Grove Area High School graduation date.
- On June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00pm, the PGAHS Virtual Graduation Ceremony will be released online.
- The School Board has officially postponed the June 3<sup>rd</sup> traditional graduation celebration.
- The School Board has officially scheduled June 24<sup>th</sup> (rain date June 25<sup>th</sup>) as our new graduation celebration date.

- The board approved two different options for celebrations. The final determination to what
  option occurs will be determined by what "level" Schuylkill County is classified on June 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - Option #1a: If we are "<u>Green</u>" on June 15<sup>th</sup> an on-field celebration will be held in Cardinal Stadium on June 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm following all recommended state guidelines.
  - Option #1b: If we are <u>"Red or Yellow" on June 15<sup>th</sup></u> a celebration parade will be held following the parade route used to celebrate district accomplishments. This event will be held on June 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm.
- The color level classification of Schuylkill County on June 15<sup>th</sup> will automatically determine what option will occur.
- The rain date for either option will be June 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Specific celebration information will be provided once the "level" is determined on June 15<sup>th</sup>.

I want to thank everyone who brought their best thinking and creative problem solving in contributing to this decision, especially our senior student leaders who brought the voices of their classmates to the table. I know how important this time is and the significance graduation merits. I also acknowledge this has not been the senior year that you've been looking forward to in so many ways both large and small. I thank you for your sacrifice, resilience and continued optimism in the face of unprecedented adversity; it matters. No matter what the circumstance... we are Pine Grove Area Proud!

4. Material Return- As our school year draws to a close, our individual schools will be setting up procedures to collect school materials. Please be on the lookout for that information.
