Student Assistance Program (SAP):

Intensive Behavioral Health Services (IBHS):

IBHS provides child-focused mental health services delivered in non-traditional community settings that can include the home, community and school to build on a child's strengths and attempt to maintain the child within their environment. Services must be determined to be medically necessary by a psychiatrist, psychologist, CRNP, LCSW, LPC.

Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT):

PCIT is an evidence-based treatment appropriate for parents of children age 2.5-7 years old. Parents learn the skills of PCIT from in-session, direct coaching by a therapist. As the parent and child interact the therapist gives suggestions to the parent through an earpiece.

Community School Based Behavioral Health (CSBBH):

CSBBH Team services are voluntary mental health services for children and teenagers with a severe emotional and/or behavioral problem that interferes with their learning. School-based services differ from other types of behavioral health services because they are usually provided in school. After school and weekends, CSBBH Team services can be provided as needed in your home or in the community.

The CSBBH Team's goal is to teach your child new ways to better manage feelings and behaviors so that he or she can learn and get along better with others. The Service may include individual, group, or family therapy sessions, as well as behavior management planning, crisis intervention, and referrals. Services build on the strengths of your child and family.

The team provides services as needed and during specific times when your child has the most difficulty. The team works with your child one-on-one, with another child, in a group, or with your family.

Children's Service Center provides this service for Schuylkill **in the following districts:**

Minersville (elementary and jr/sr high), Pottsville (elementary, middle and high), North Schuylkill (elementary) Schuylkill Haven (elementary), Pine Grove (elementary and middle)

Early Intervention Services:

Early intervention services are offered to pre-school children that have developmental disabilities. SAM offers service coordination for children ages 0-3. The Schuylkill IU#29 offers services for children ages 3-5.

Community-Based Drug and Alcohol Treatment:

Community-based drug and alcohol treatment offers individual and family therapy using a team-based approach, case coordination and family support services, parent education, and crisis intervention services. Treatment is offered in the home, school and community.

Community Residential Rehabilitation Host Home (CRR Host Home):

This level of service provides out-of-home placement for children and adolescents in foster care settings within the community. Residents receive services based on their need e.g. individual and family therapy, medication monitoring, and therapeutic staff support. Educational services are provided within the local school district. Emphasis is placed on reunification of the child with the family. ****Requires recommendation from psychologist or psychiatrist****

Residential Treatment Facility(RTF) :

Residential Treatment Facilities provide out-of-home placement for children and adolescents in unsecured residential settings. All facilities are certified by the Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services. Residents receive intensive treatment with stress being placed on recommendations for discharge and return home to family and community. Numerous residential facilities are located throughout the state. A recommendation by a **PSYCHIATRIST** is needed for this placement. This is the highest level of care and all other previously listed services should be tried before this option.

Crisis Intervention/Emergency Services:

Crisis intervention provides 24/7 intervention on an emergency basis via telephone, mobile crisis workers and a walk in center.

Community Care Behavioral Health:

Many of the children who have Medical Assistance are now served through the Managed Care Agency, Community Care Behavioral Health Organization (CCBH). This opens the door to the possibility of additional provider agencies outside of Schuylkill County providing services for children. **The number for CCBH is 1-866-878-6046**

Child and Adolescent Service System Program (CASSP):

The CASSP team is composed of key persons from all child-serving agencies - The child and family, MH/DS, Children & Youth, Drug & Alcohol, Education, Juvenile Justice, etc. The team meets on a weekly basis to problem solve, address children's issues, and assist in the development of a coordinated service plan. Various issues discussed may pertain to children who are at risk of out-of-home placement, children returning home from out-of-home placement, a child and/or family who is having difficulty accessing services, children involved in two or more non-educational CASSP systems, or issues involving the child's educational placement. A meeting date and time may be requested by any person involved with the child and/or family.
