

Pine Grove Area School District Special Education Data Report

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) or federal special education law requires each state to report annually to the public on the performance of each LEA (Local Education Agency/school district) in the state on the targets established in the State Performance Plan (SPP). States are required to report LEA performance on the following SPP indicators for students with disabilities: *Graduation rates, Dropout Rates, Participation and Performance on Statewide Assessments, Suspension Rates, Educational Environments, School-Facilitated Parent Involvement, Disproportionate Representation by Race/Ethnicity in Specific Disability Categories, Timelines for Initial Evaluations, IEP Secondary Transition Goals and Services and Post-School Outcomes.*

To fulfill the SPP public reporting requirement, each school district has an online Special Education Data Report that shows local performance each year on the indicators mentioned above. There may be instances in which the LEA's report will not have the data for each indicator for several reasons. The LEA may not have been monitored during that school year, or the data set was too small to be reported.
