1. CALL TO ORDER - Dave Lukasewicz called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

2. GENERAL UPDATES

- Mike reviewed the Student Representative selection process. He talked through the interviewing process and how the applicants are selected. Mike introduced Zofia Fegley as the Student Representative for the 2025-2026 school year.
- Dr. Suzanne Dubbs talked about receiving her doctorate, what that process/schooling looked like, and thanked the Board.

3. BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS

- A. *D. Frew made a motion, seconded by G. Moyer* to approve accepting East Coast Contracting's Change Order 1 in the amount of \$61,249.85. The cost for this work will be taken from the board approved Funds for Public School Environmental Repairs Program Project Grant.

- B. *D. Frew made a motion, seconded by R. Stump* to approve purchasing classroom and office furniture at cost not to exceed \$74,873.81. The cost for this work will be taken from the Board Approved Funds for the Public School Environmental Repairs Program Grant Project and is a COSTARS #035-E22-183 purchase.

4. PRINCIPALS' AND DIRECTORS' REPORTS

Mike – End of the school year went well. Graduation week was great, and graduation night itself was excellent.

Bill – ESY started today, starting interviews for next school year right away.

Rich – Great end of the year, already looking forward to next school year. Wrapping up end of the year and diving into what next school year will look like.

Corey – In regard to behaviors, 40% discipline referrals went down and in school/out of school went down as well. PBIS initiative – 70% were eligible every month and 40% received no marks all year.

Sandy – Busy end of the year. Observed every teacher in the ES this year. Felt like it was a growing year for the Elementary School.

Steph – 17 students are signed up for Summer Credit Recovery – 1 Middle School and 16 High School. Courses open up on Monday. PSSA final scores will be in on 6/24/2025. Keystone scores will be in on 7/14/2025.

Scott – Baseball had a nice run at the end of the year and qualified for Districts. Track and Field at 6 PIAA meets, 2 being gold. Softball won States and had one of the longest games.
